Celia Lawley, a native San Diegan, graduated from classical music studies at the University of Southern California's prestigious Thornton School of music with a degree in violin performance under the tutelage of Alice Schoenfield, attending on full scholarship for both music and scholastic achievement, graduating with honors in chamber music. Following graduation she began teaching and exploring and performing popular styles of music including country, folk, Celtic, jazz, blues, rock, latin jazz & Cajun/ zydeco.

She has been teaching violin in group classes in various studios & privately since graduation and has designed a comprehensive music method of improvisation for violin/fiddle called Little Uk's, Fiddletime Is Fun Time for children and The Performance Academy for Adults. The method focuses on both reading and improvisation and learning in a gently progressive, yet rapid, fun way. The above systems provide a base of classical technique using American & Celtic fiddle tunes.

Celia plays 10 instruments and teaches violin/fiddle. She uses ukulele as a transitional instrument when starting children at age 3-5.

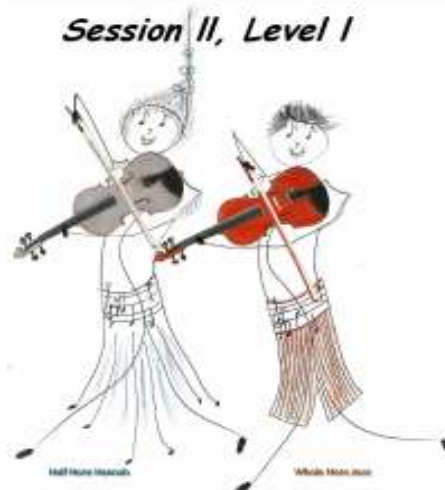
